CODE OF CONDUCT AT HIGH SCHOOL CONTESTS

Herriman High School belongs to the Utah High School Activities Association and supports the UHSAA Sportsmanship Program, "**Raise-the-Bar**" because **SPORTSMANSHIP MATTERS!**

We recognize the importance of good sportsmanship and appropriate behavior when participating in or attending high school extracurricular activities.

Herriman High School will enforce the following **Code of Conduct** for all players, spectators, students and fans. Violations of the following standards shall not be tolerated and may result in penalties against the individual, team or school. Spectators or fans may be asked to leave and/or barred from attending future contests. It is our intent to provide a safe and positive environment for our Utah students to participate and for our fans to enjoy.

1. Extracurricular activities are an extension of the school day and as such require participants, spectators and fans to act in an appropriate manner.
2. Refrain from engaging in derogatory, demeaning or embarrassing chants, cheers, or comments directed at players, teams, coaches or officials.
3. **Do Rowdy Right: cheer FOR your team and NOT against your opponent!**
4. Respect the game and all of the participants.
 - Show respect to opposing players, coaches, cheerleaders and fans.
 - Respect decisions made by the referees and other officials.
5. Do not taunt or opposing players or coaches.
6. Do not harass referees, players or coaches before, during or after games.
7. Win with class and lose with dignity.
